## **MISSIONARY UPDATE**

The following is an update on the lives of the Missionaries we support and stay in touch with as they continue to offer Christ to a lost and hurting world.

In a recent e-mail from the Fritzler family they state they are still building their house and will be using it as the Belize Bible Center until one can be built. Right now they are in need of \$22,000 to be able to finish that construction. Please pray that they will be able to find the financing to finish this project.

The Tiner's are still in turmoil about their visa being rescinded. They are still waiting to receive their official letter of rejection and their exit visa. Otherwise they are slowly packing and waiting for what God has planned for them. At this time they are planning on taking an early furlough which will allow them to be at our auction June 5. Please continue to pray for them.

Ralph and Maryana Rice are still on the move. They have stayed a little closer to home by doing ministries in Texas and Tennessee. They are still so blessed by what Countryside does for them when they come. They haven't found bigger hearts in all the churches that have thousands of members - than they do right here at little Countryside.

Rafeeq and Irene Ali are also very thankful for the abundance Countryside has bestowed on them. Please pray for Rafeeq as he travels the world in 2010. As you know he often goes into areas that are dangerous and must travel underground.

We were very blessed to have Laura Knurr with us recently to tell about her missions' trip to Costa Rica. Laura is taking on more responsibility in Wyoming and is asking for our prayers that God will lead her and show her the way for 2010 in her new responsibilities.

We received a letter from the MAR, Manager of Recruiting regarding John and Nancy Hook. Johns' responsibility with them has changed. He will be recruiting candidates from California, Arizona, Texas, and Colorado. He will no longer be flying into foreign countries, but stationed here in the states. He will continue to be in charge of the yearly flight camp for teenagers and running the vision internship trips. Nancy will continue to run the housing for interns. Please keep them in your prayers.

Our own warriors, the Campbell's, are such a blessing to Countryside in all that they do. Doug is now Information Technologies Recruiter for WYCLIFFE Bible Translators. So far they will be able to work in Oshkosh with short training trips to Florida. Please keep them in your prayers.

Please pray for all our missionaries that they will be successful in sharing the Bible with people of foreign countries. They face hardships that we may never know, but are so blessed to have the Lord watching over them. Our prayers are needed as much as our financial support.
